

# STUDENT SCHOOL BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

## Student Behavior Contract

Information recorded under this Contract is part of the Student's education record under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), 20 U.S.C. §1232g and 34 C.F.R. Part 99. The School will maintain these records in accordance with FERPA and District policy. The Parent/Guardian (or an eligible student age 18+) has the right to inspect and review the records, request amendments, and consent (or withhold consent) to disclosure except as authorized by FERPA.

## **8. Information Sharing**
